### OVERVIEW

This program has been designed by industry experts to address environmental issues, Legislation and strategic leadership to implement Environmental Management System (EMS). Environment is defined by our surroundings and interaction in relation to where we live, work and commute. However, keeping environment safe is vital as environmental factors attributed to 24% of global diseases and 23% of deaths.

In Pakistan we are constantly exposed to poor air quality, inhalation of chemicals, unsafe water, lack of access to sanitation, Air pollution, Poor waste management, unsafe working conditions, Land degradation and deforestation. The World Bank reports that these environmental factors are accounting for 40 million cases of acute respiratory infections and 28,000 deaths per year in Pakistan. It results in diminishing human capital and loss to the businesses.

Pakistan is in a dire need to adapt global Environmental standards, specially being declared among the top ten countries most affected by climate change. Pakistan as a country will face severe weather disruptions and issues due to greenhouse effect, posing a high risk for business continuity as Environmental Degradation costs Pakistan 1 Billion rupees per day.

The striking facts highlights a need to establish climate resilient and environment friendly infrastructure. Business sector would play a vital role to evolve socially responsible organisations. Pakistan Environmental Protection Act, 1997 (PEPA) clearly imply the need to control emissions, waste, water and air pollutants. Violation to these standards implies heavy fines and imprisonment to non-compliant business owners. Although in vogue for over two decades, enforcement of PEPA has been a major challenge.
